Fee Structure

Course work per hour \$ 60

The course work fee of \$60 per hour **is a suggested rate**. This rate may vary slightly per branch office, depending on the going rates in a specific area of the USA. For the exact hourly rate, contact your branch instructor.

The annual enrollment fee has been eliminated and has been replaced by an examination fee.

The compensation for the actual lessons will be payable directly to the branch office instructor, or the “online” instructors for Marketing, Campanology and/or Arranging, without interference of the NACS administration.

The examination fee will be payable to the NACS Headquarters.

Students are responsible to schedule their lessons, and mutually agree upon their lesson date and time, with their instructor(-s).

Half-hour sessions are also an option, especially in case of remote education (Skype, E-media, Email etc.). The duration of the lessons to be agreed upon by student and instructor.

For utilizing Skype or other E-media, students are responsible for providing their own equipment necessary to conduct e-classes.

Examination Fees

Proficiency Certificate: \$150

Performance Diploma: \$250

Additional fees for jurors will apply in case exam is to take place on Candidate's “local” carillon, or on a date not coinciding with the set annual NACS examination date in Springfield, IL in June every year.
